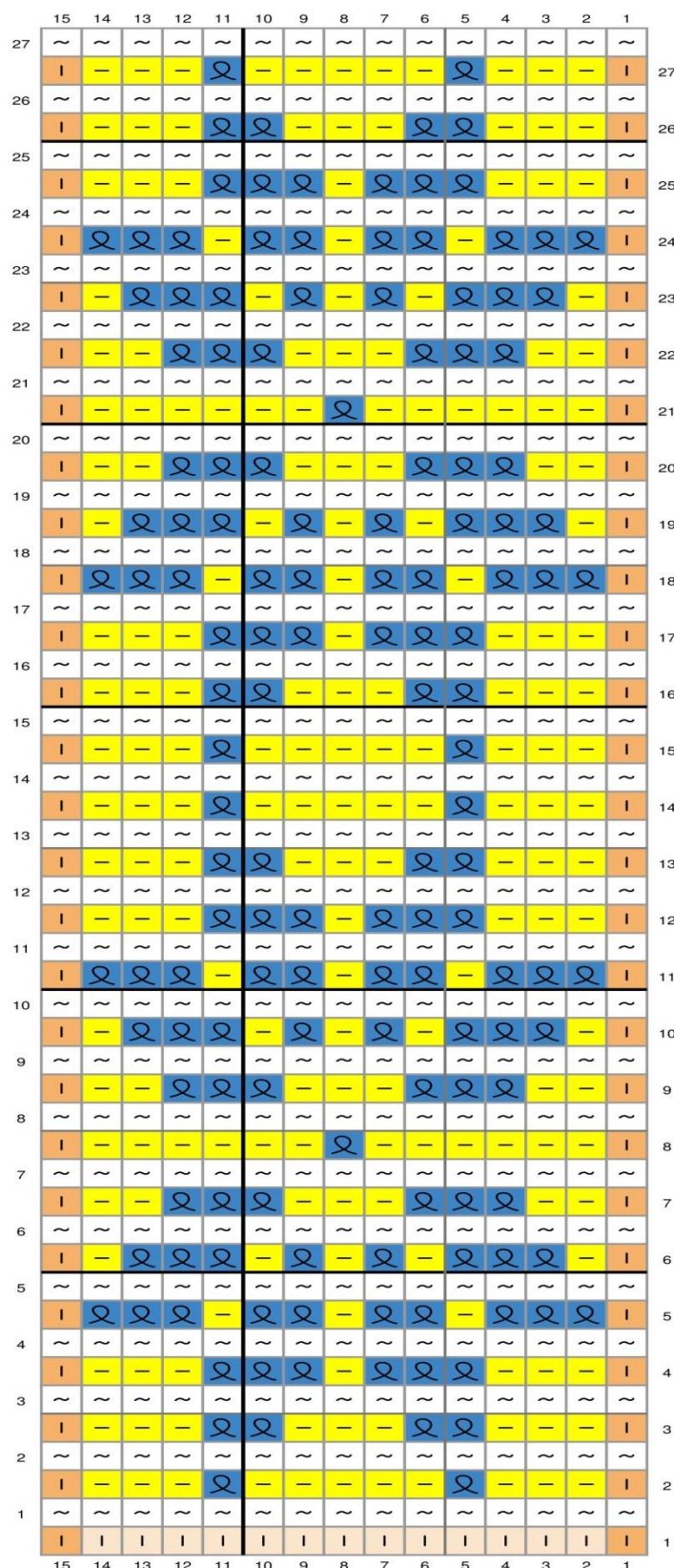




Block 25: to attach, count over 13 stitches from the vertical line on left. Join in back between 13th and 14th stitch. Pick up 13 loops in back across and make connection. (15 loops)

Block 26*design: Marjolein*

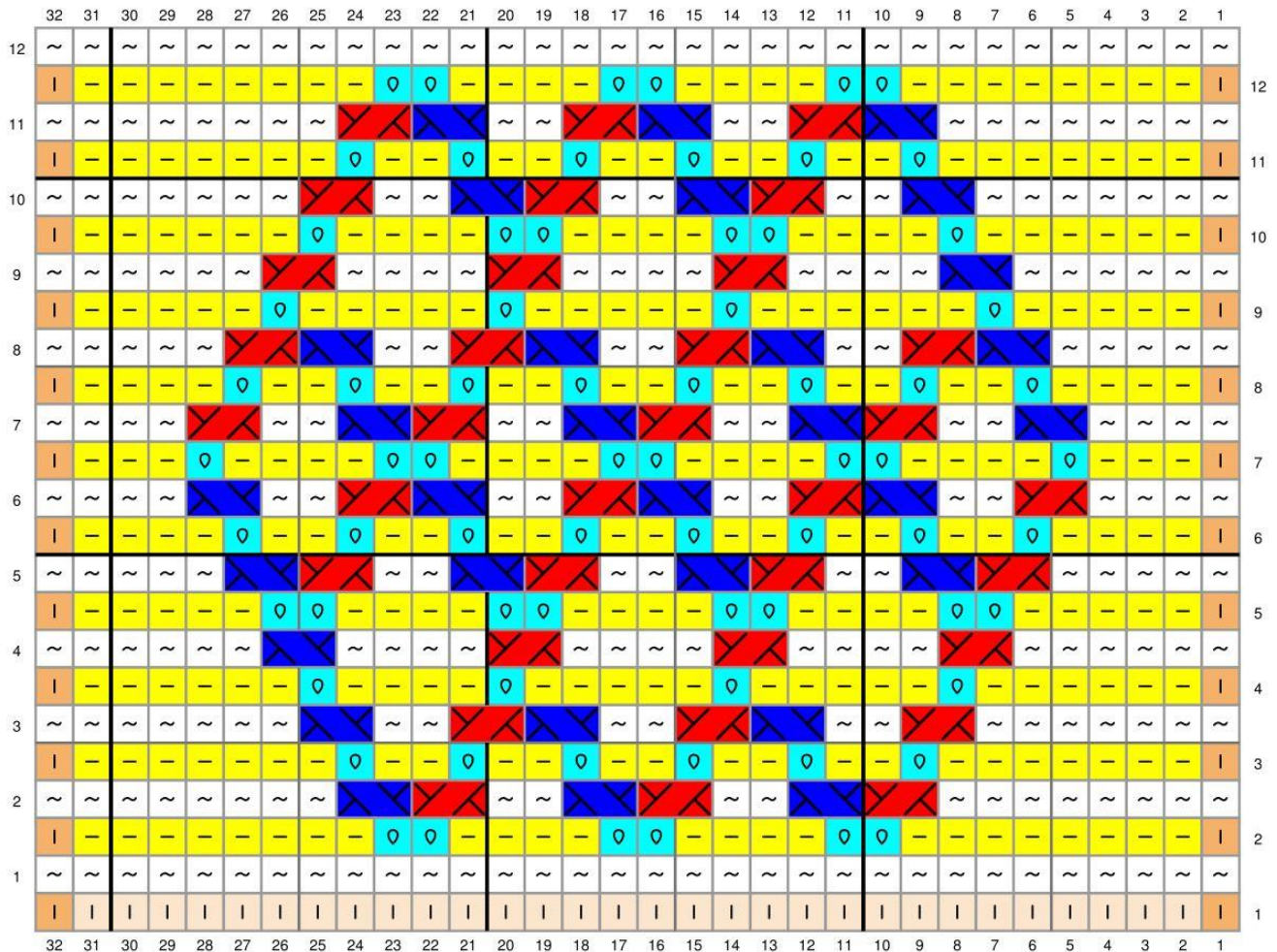
Yes, another block with a cable. I cannot help it! I love cables and there are so many different patterns.

Block 26: to attach, count over 13 loops on top of Block 16 from the vertical line on the left of that block, join and pick up 30 loops (32 loops).



Block 27*design: Kiki*

Okay, are you ready for a new stitch? Pick up your swatch and let's start practicing.

Tunisian Full Stitch - TFS

This is a very easy stitch. First insert your hook between the 2 stitches from front to back and pull up a loop. Use the following 2 rows for straight pattern.

Block 27: join yarn behind border stitch on right top edge of Block 26

Swatch - Tunisian Full Stitch - TFS

Make a row of TSS.

Row 1

Insert your hook between the first stitch and the second stitch, from front to back and pick up a loop. Work all the stitches. You will make the last TFS between the last stitch and the border stitch.






Row 2

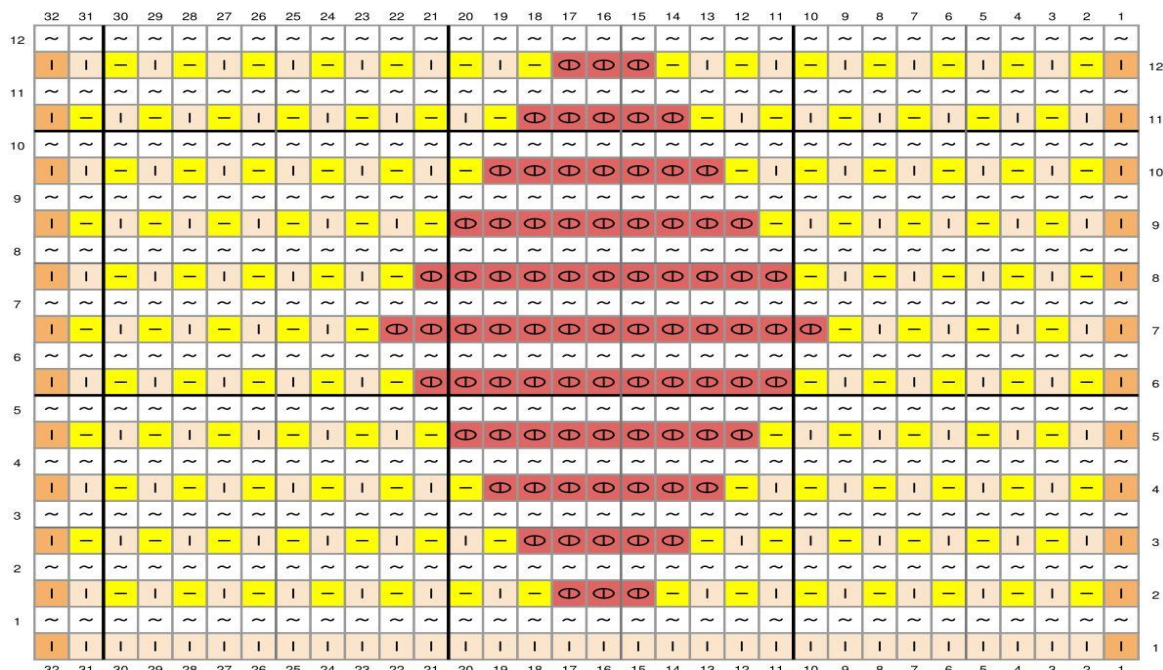
Insert your hook between the border stitch and the first stitch and pull up a loop. Work all the stitches. The last stitch is before the last stitch of previous row.

YOU DO NOT MAKE A STITCH BETWEEN THE LAST STITCH AND THE BORDER STITCH!!!!









Block 28**design: Marjolein**

This is another pattern I am using in a lovely WIP (work in progress), a large cabled heart. It looks like a pattern from my Discover the Seasons Blanket, but this one has a honey comb centre.

Block 28: count over 4 sts from right on last made vertical line and join, pick up 47 loops
