Lines of the Medium and Large Blanket

<i>After block</i>	<i>Next to block</i>	<i>On top of block</i>	<i>Bind off row</i>

We have a new combination stitch called the Cross Stitch. It is a little different then a cable. I learned this stitch from Kim Guzman. You can practice the stitch on your swatch.

Cross Stitch

Skip the vertical bar, insert your hook under the next vertical bar and pull up a loop (TSS). Now go back to the skipped vertical bar, insert hook (TSS) and pull up a loop. Do this for all the indicated stitches.

Attaching;

Block 41. Count over 30 loops and place marker and join in back, pick up 30 loops for total of 32 loops on hook. Also place marker at 34th loop for the vertical line

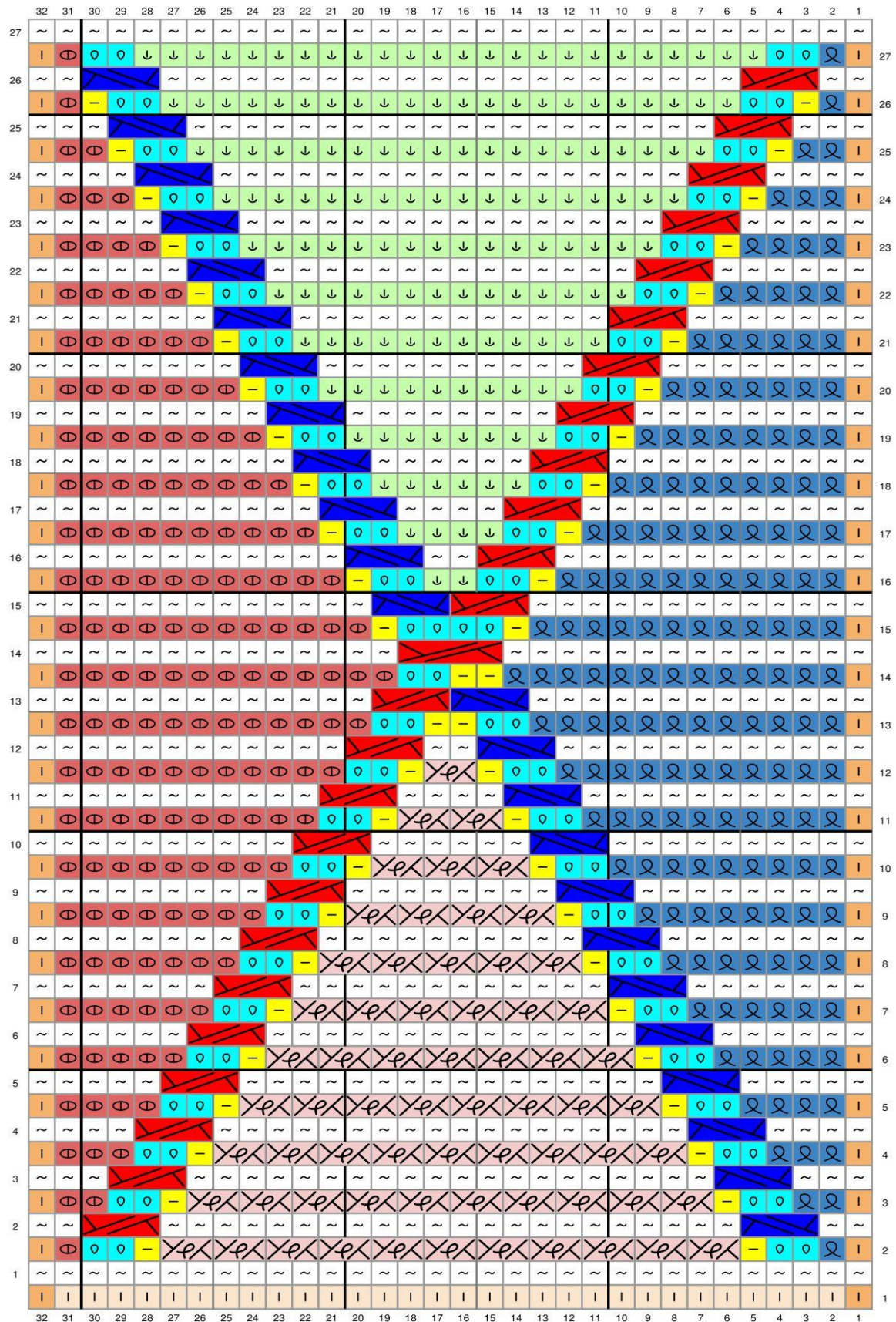

Insert hook from left to right and from front to back and pull up a loop

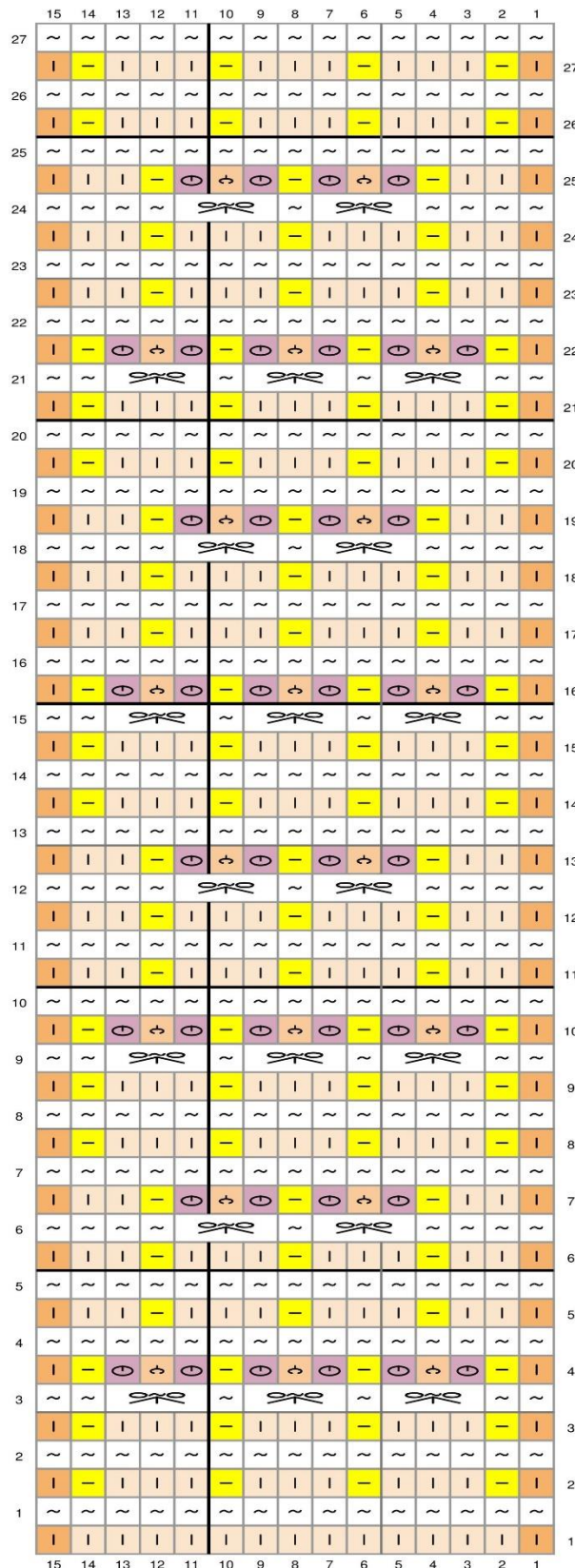

A variation on Block 12.

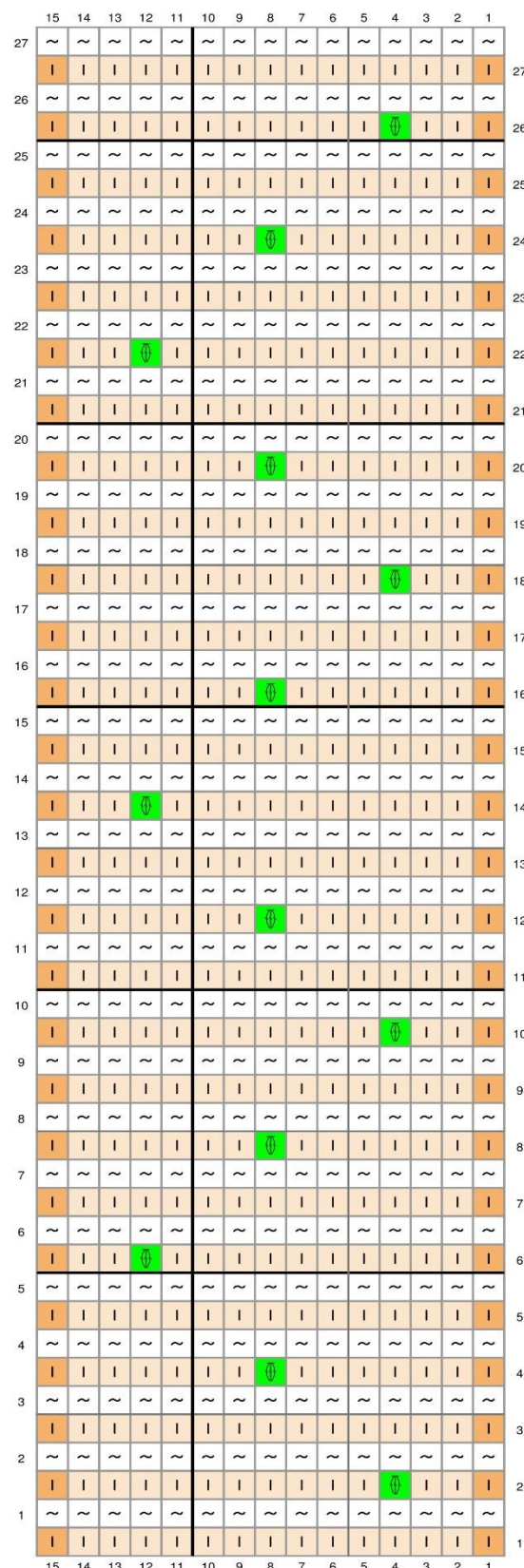
Attaching;

Block 42 count over 13 loops and place marker (to start Block 42) and at 17th loop (for vertical line), join in back and pick up 13 loops and connection stitch for a total of 15 loops on hook.

A bobble stitch can be made with different stitches.

Bobble

Step 1-making 3 TDS (Tunisian Double Stitch) in indicated stitch: {YO, insert hook (TKS) and pull up a loop, YO and pull through 2 loops}. Repeat this 3 times in the same stitch. (3 loops on the hook)





Step 2: YO and pull through 3 loops

Attaching;

Place marker at 5th stitch from right edge and join in back, picking up 13 loops and a connection stitch for a total of 15 loops on hook.

This is a new challenge for you. I searched in some very old knitting books and found this beautiful pattern. But it needed a little explanation because it is the first time I am using this kind of chart.

Abbreviations

TSS	<i>Tun Simple Stitch</i>
TPS	<i>Tun Purl Stitch</i>
TKS	<i>Tun Knit Stitch</i>
TOG	<i>Together</i>
YO	<i>Yarn Over</i>

In the chart there are white squares, they are placed to remind you of an increase or decrease. It is not showing a stitch!!!! In Row 5 you are going to make an increase. So I needed extra space to show you what to do with those stitches in the rows above. You will decrease those stitches in the next few rows.

Attaching: Place marker at 5th stitch from right edge and join in back, picking up 30 loops and a connection stitch for a total of 32 loops on hook.
