Kiki created a beautiful and surprising diamond pattern. It has a lovely twist in it, I hope you like as much as I do.

#### Attaching

Count over 47 loops from the vertical line next to Block 47 and place a stitch marker. Count over 4 more loops and place another stitch marker to be used later for the line. vertical line. Join in the back of the marked stitch and pick up 47 loops and the connection. (49 loops on hook)

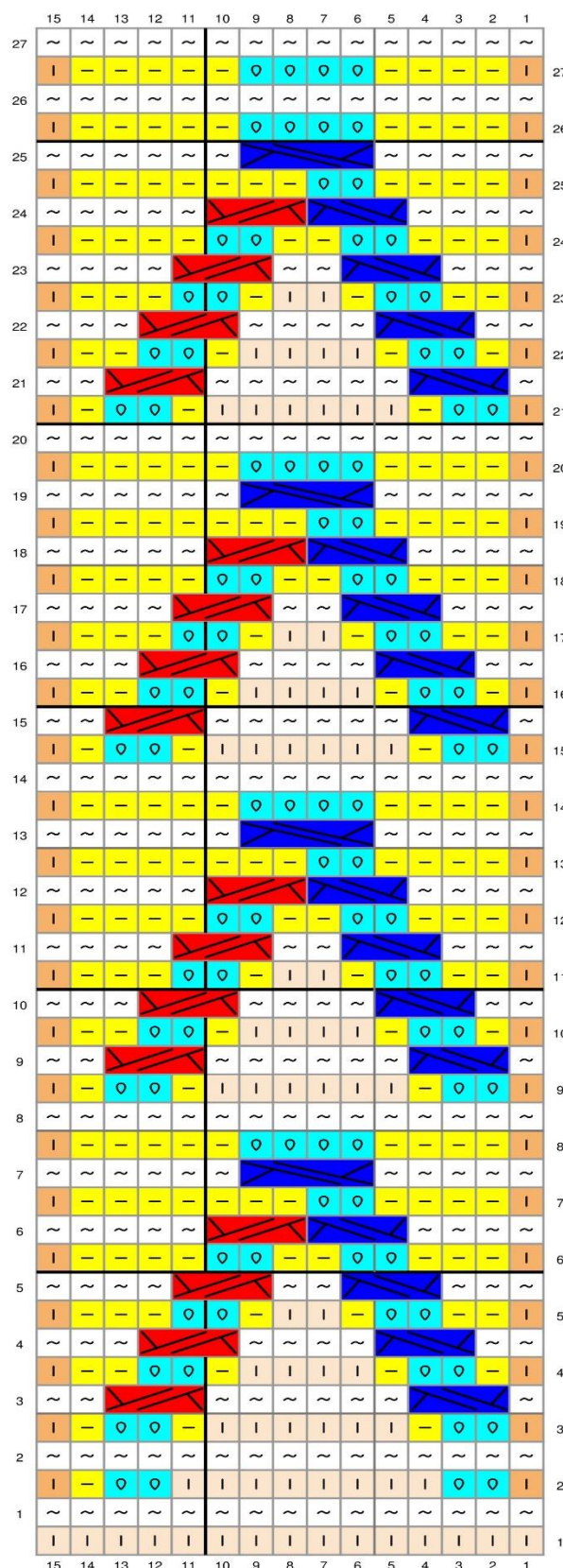
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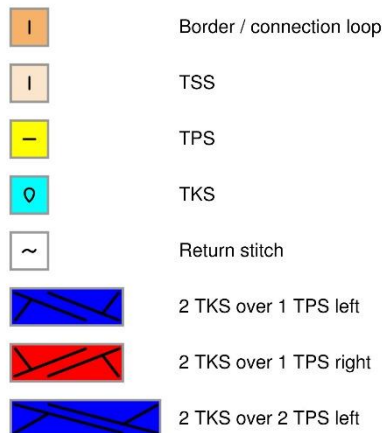


## Abbreviations

## Attaching

Starting at the left corner of the vertical line for Block 65, count over 13 loops and place your first stitch marker, then count an additional 4 loops and place another stitch marked in the 17<sup>th</sup> loop for the vertical line. Join in back of the first stitch marked and pick up 13 loops and the connection. (15 loops on hook)









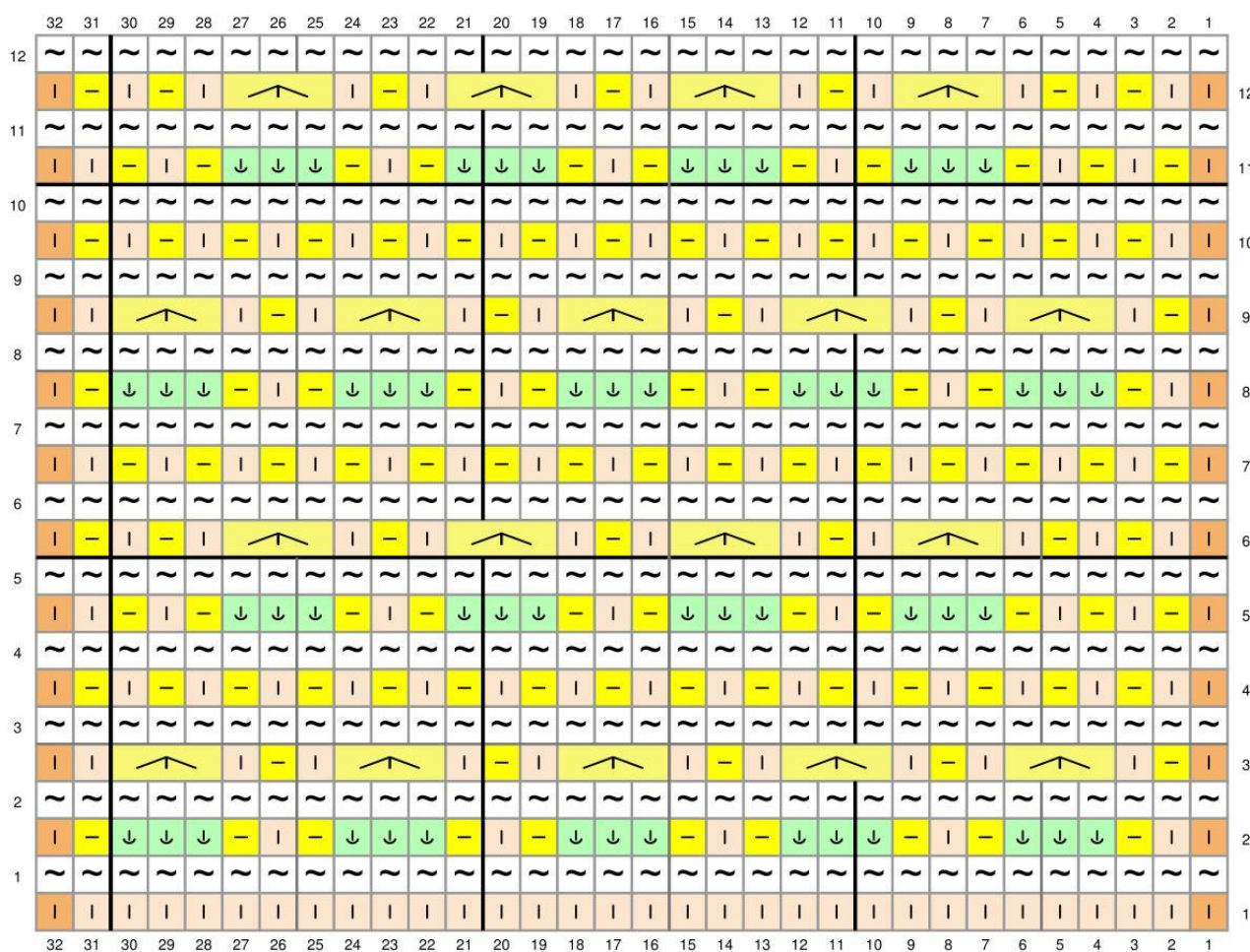
**Abbreviations****TSS** Tun Simple Stitch**TPS** Tun Purl Stitch**TKS** Tun Knit Stitch**Star Stitch**

Hook under next 3 vertical bars and pull up a loop, yarn over,  
Hook under same 3 vertical bars and pull up a loop

**Attaching**

Starting at the far right edge, count in to the 5<sup>th</sup> loop from the edge and join in the back, picking up 30 loops and the connection. (32 loops on the hook)

The smock stitch is a beautiful and popular stitch. Kiki has made a chart for it.

You need to be careful when you are working this. Look closely at the beginning and the end of each row. Do not forget to skip that stitch!

**Yarn Under, 2TOG**

Lay your yarn from front to back over your hook, HOLD IT TIGHT!!!, insert hook under next 2 vertical bars and pull up a loop.

Repeat this for all indicated stitches.

**Attaching**

Starting at the far right edge join in the back of the horizontal line, picking up 30 loops and the connection. (32 loops on the hook)
